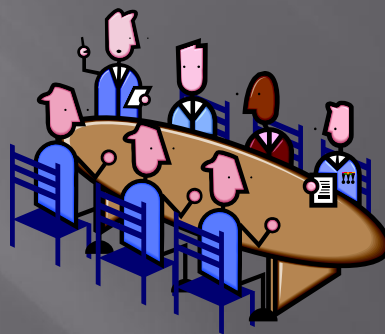

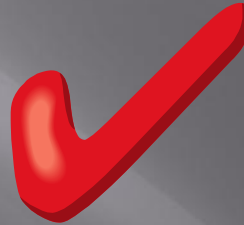

Purpose

2. Initial purpose will be to coordinate development of state IP network for 9-1-1
 - ANGEN (Alabama Next Generation Emergency Network)
 - develop a network that will be shared by other agencies with 9-1-1
 - by sharing network, we can share data and costs

Purpose

3. Develop a state 9-1-1 plan for the DOT/DOC E9-1-1 grant application.

- \$43.5 million authorized through the Enhance 911 Act of 2004
- minimum award for AL: \$686,230.25
- due Aug 4, 2009
- awarded by September 30, 2009
- one of requirements is a State 9-1-1 Plan

Development of State 9-1-1 Plan

- Jan. 22 ALNENA quarterly meeting, \$15,000 approved by membership to hire consultant to write plan
- RFP issued Feb. 10, 2009
- Received 5 responses
- March 3, met in Montgomery to review RFPs and decide on consultant
- David Aylward, COMCARE
- Mar. 26, project began
- Complete on June 17

 - Conference call on July 8 with interested vendors
 - edits by July 14
 - pricing due July 21
 - Grant submitted July 28

- BTOP (Broadband Technology Opportunities Program) \$4.7 billion

- American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009
- awards by Sept. 30, 2009

- Future grants and stimulus funds
