8 SYNOPSIS: Under existing law, certain sheriffs and  
9 sheriff's deputies do not receive hazardous duty  
10 pay.

11 This bill would provide that certain  
12 sheriffs and sheriff's deputies may receive a \$10  
13 per day or \$5 per day hazardous duty pay,  
14 respectively, and would provide exemptions.

20 Relating to sheriffs and sheriff's deputies; to  
21 provide for hazardous duty pay and to provide exemptions.

22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

23 Section 1. Commencing on the first day of the month  
24 immediately following the effective date of this act, any  
25 sheriff in the state shall be entitled to an additional  
26 expense allowance in the amount of ten dollars (\$10) for each  
27 working day of a pay period as hazardous duty pay while

1 engaged in the performance of the duties of sheriff, which  
2 expense allowance shall be in addition to all other expense  
3 allowances, compensation, or salary provided by law from the  
4 general fund of the county.

5 Section 2. Beginning with the expiration of the term  
6 of any incumbent sheriff receiving the additional expense  
7 allowance for hazardous duty pursuant to Section 1, the annual  
8 salary shall be as provided by law, including an expense  
9 allowance of ten dollars (\$10) for each working day of a pay  
10 period as hazardous duty pay while engaged in the performance  
11 of the duties of sheriff from the general fund of the county  
12 and at that time, Section 1 shall become null and void.

13 Section 3. Any sheriff's deputy in the state shall  
14 receive hazardous duty pay of five dollars (\$5) for each  
15 working day of a pay period while engaged in the performance  
16 of the duties as a law enforcement officer. This pay shall be  
17 in addition to all other compensation and expenses provided  
18 those sheriffs and sheriff's deputies from the general fund of  
19 the county.

20 Section 4. This act shall not apply to any sheriff  
21 or sheriff's deputy receiving hazardous duty pay from his or  
22 her county on the effective date of this act.

23 Section 5. This act shall become effective on the  
24 first day of the third month following its passage and  
25 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
